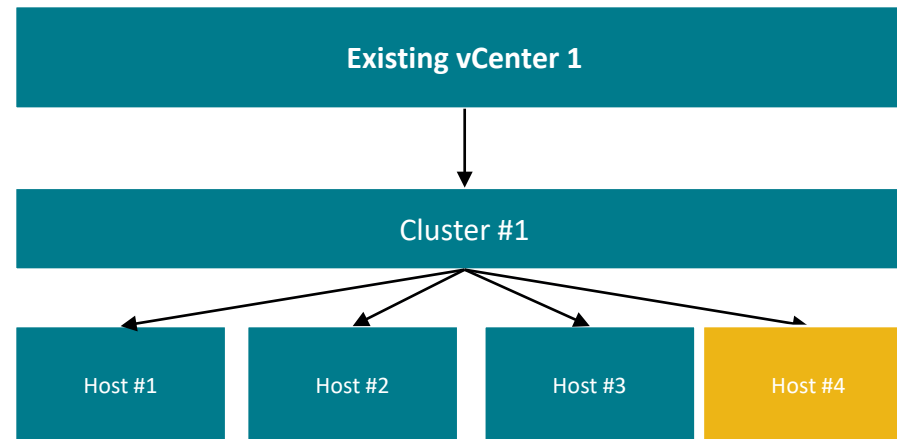

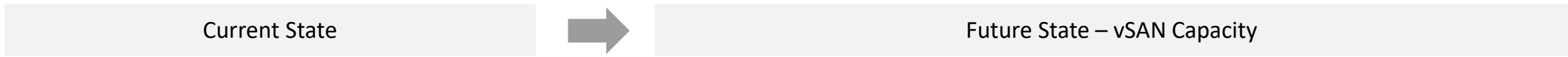




# Mixing: vSAN Licensing Expansion Scenario #1

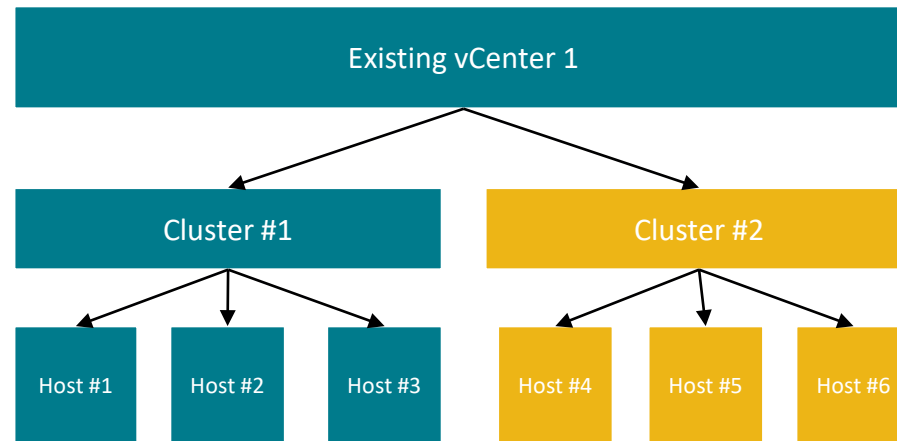
## Existing Perpetual/Term License

- vSAN perpetual or term license (CPU or Core)

- vSAN License Key is applied at the cluster level
- Required to create new Cluster; vSAN perpetual and subscription legacy license keys cannot be merged with new license keys



The primary options to use the new subscription offers in vSAN brownfield environments are: 1) create a net new cluster as illustrated above 2) insert more storage disks into existing hosts 3) purchase subscriptions to license existing and new hosts in the cluster.

As a last resort, see the following slide for the exception to expand the vSAN cluster, as long as the condition is met, and customers renew vSAN subscriptions when the legacy offer (SnS or subscription) expire. Reviewing the vSAN Q&A section in the FAQ for unique considerations on license key fulfillment and vSAN cluster expansion options with legacy offers is recommended.

# Solution License Key - VCF

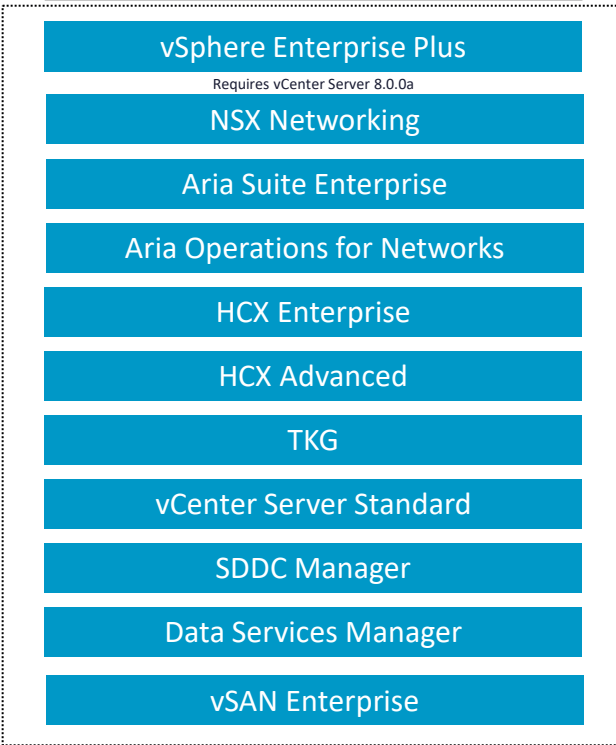
VMware Cloud Foundation is sold and licensed as a single product. The introduction of a solution license key is a first step in the enablement of this single offering entitlement. For full licensing rules governing VCF as a single product, please see the [PnP Policy and FAQ](#).

Beginning with VCF 5.1.1, the "vSphere 8 Enterprise Plus for VCF" license key is the Solution license key for VCF and unlocks all VCF component features (except for vSAN, which is still applied separately). All component license keys will continue to appear in the Customer Connect Portal so that brownfield customers are not forced to upgrade.

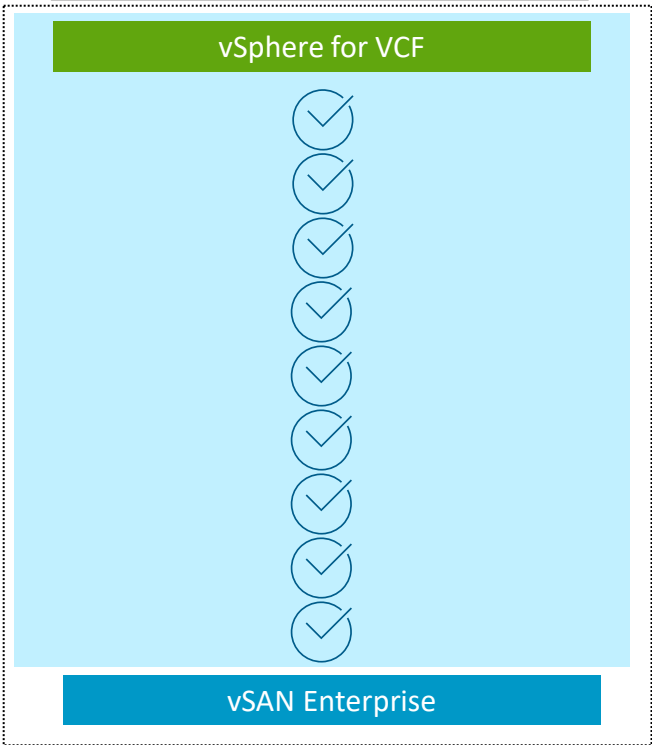

# Solution License Key - VCF

## Details

### Greenfield Customers

---

- The customer will first add the "vSphere 8 Enterprise Plus for VCF" solution license key directly to vCenter
- The customer will manually assign the solution license key to the following: (however there is a bulk Licensing option in the vCenter UI.) --This step will be automated in future releases
  - vCenter
  - ESXi hosts
  - TKG Supervisor Clusters
  - The separate vSAN key will need to be applied to vSAN clusters
- Customer will add the VCF-enabled vCenter as Data Source/Integration to Aria, NSX, and HCX.

### Brownfield Customers

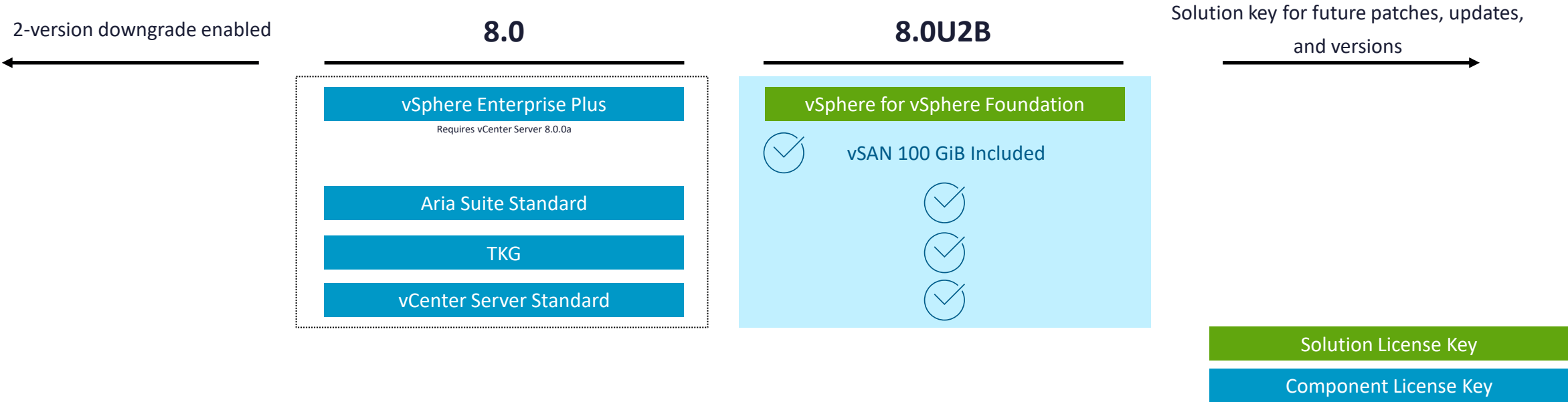
---

- For a customer running a version prior to 5.1.1, this customer must downgrade the "vSphere 8 Enterprise Plus for VCF" license key
  - At this point, the license key will become a vSphere 8 Enterprise Plus component license key rather than the solution license key.
- The customer still receives all component license keys for use with versions prior to 5.1.1
- When the customer is ready to upgrade to 5.1.1, the customer can upgrade the vSphere license key back to being the solution license key
- The customer will manually assign the solution license key to ESXi hosts (the separate vSAN key is assigned to vSAN clusters); this step will be automated in a future release
- The customer will add this VCF-enabled vCenter as Data Source/Integration to Aria, NSX, and HCX.

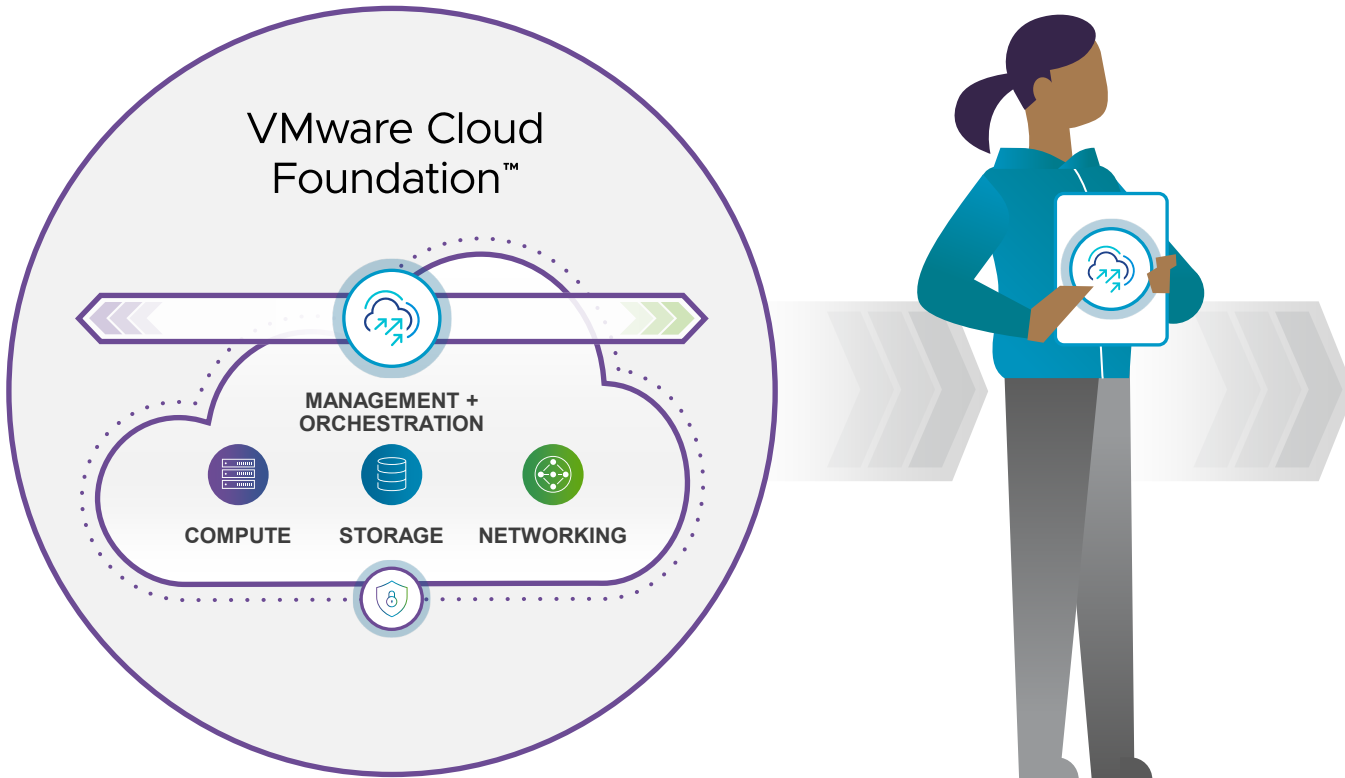

- The customer still receives all component license keys for use with versions prior to 8.0U2b
- When the customer is ready to upgrade to 8.0U2b, the customer can upgrade the vSphere license key back to being the solution license key
- The customer will need to assign the solution license key to ESXi hosts
