Digital Classroom.

Dynamic teaching options.

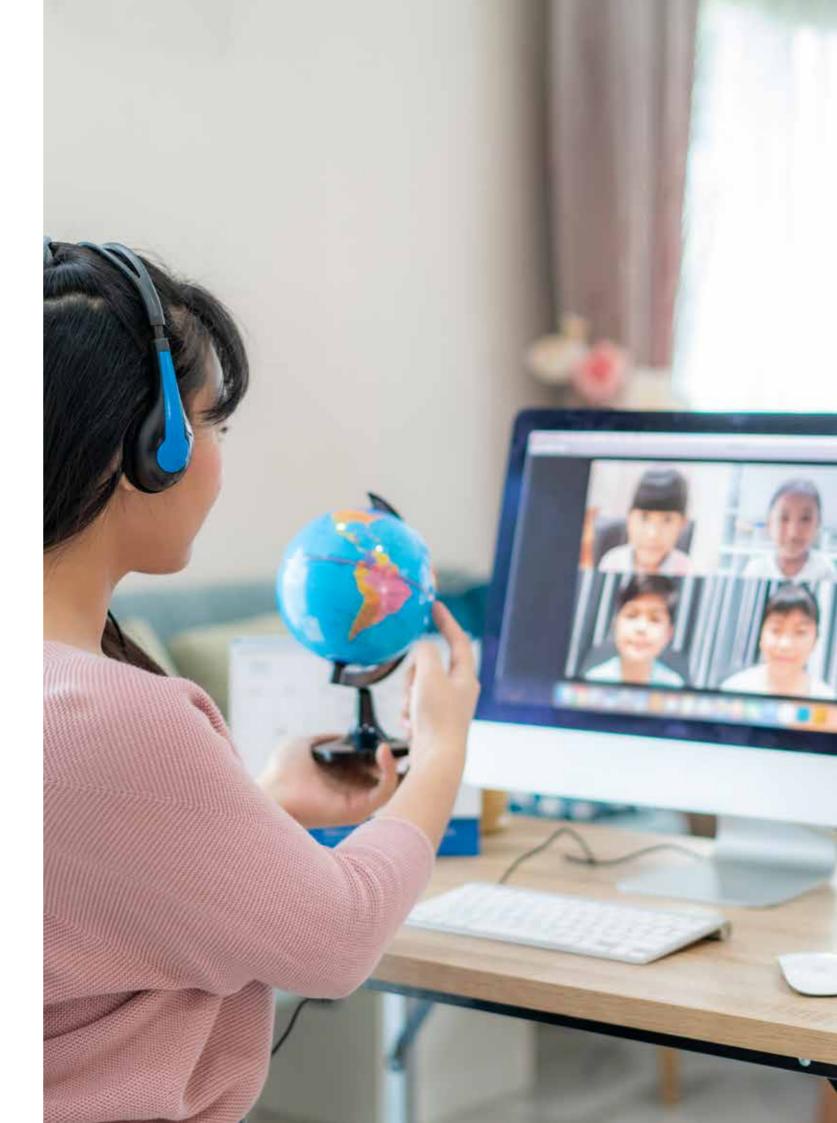

The options are endless with a properly devised video system. For example, you could elect to have a camera that follows the teacher's movements. This would give the teacher the freedom to move around in the room and the ability to show multiple types of material and content to students.

Another option is a fixed camera in a small auditorium or several fixed camera points. The same applies to audio.

Depending on the size of the room, you can position extra microphones at strategic points to ensure that every voice can be heard.

Visual Solutions for Digital Teaching.

- I A whiteboard camera allows you to communicate digitally via a graphic representation or a diagram.
- I Teachers can use a remote control to highlight the most important aspects of a diagram for the students.
- An interactive digital display. If you want to go fully digital, you can also choose an interactive display that effectively participates in teaching. The students can choose whether to view the lesson on the display or via the teacher's camera. A combination of the two is also possible in order to get a clear picture of both the subject matter and the teacher.
